

Child with ASD

- ✓ A child with a medical diagnosis of ASD only qualifies for IEP if specialized instruction is needed.
- ✓ A medical diagnosis may not be required to determine a student's eligibility with an ASD.
- ✓ A solid educational identification of eligibility informs appropriate services.
- ✓ To qualify for ASD there must be impact in each of the three core areas
(Communication, Social, Restrictive/Repetitive Behaviors)

To be Eligible as ASD All Three Conditions Must Apply

- ✓ There must be documented evidence of impairment in social, communication and restricted repetitive patterns of interests and/or activities.

AND

- ✓ The disability must be significant enough that educational performance is adversely affected.

AND

- ✓ The disability must create a need for specialized instruction.
